Partners for Breast Cancer Care, Inc. is dedicated to funding breast screening, diagnostic testing, surgery and treatment for uninsured, low-income women and men in SWFL at no cost to our client. We have been serving our community for 32 years. In the past 16 years, we have helped 11,510 SWFL residents and funded 17,894 breast care procedures at an expenditure of \$2,401,701. Of those helped, 212 have been diagnosed through our efforts. Many of our clients must choose between feeding their families and getting breast health care.

Partners for Breast Cancer Care was established in June of 1990 as part of a large cancer research project funded by a National Cancer Institute grant to the University of Vermont. The grant provided early detection of breast cancer to low-income women in Lee County by offering education about breast self-exam and mammography. Several women were identified as having breast cancer and because they had no insurance and few had the funds to pay for any treatment, most were not receiving the additional care they needed. The individuals working on the reserve project felt very strongly that continuity of care should be provided to these women. As a result, Lee County Breast Screening Program, a 501(c) (3), was born and later renamed Partners for Breast Cancer Care. Our mission is to save lives and reduce suffering from breast cancer through improved early detection, education and access to healthcare. The goal of the organization is to continue subsidizing the screening, diagnosis and treatment of breast cancer for women and men in Lee County. Due to the overwhelming need for our no-cost services, we recently expanded into Collier, Charlotte, Hendry & Glades Counties.

A need was identified in our community to provide assistance to individuals, especially women who were at high risk for non-participation, usually for low-income households. We continually strive to meet the needs of more and more women and men, who do not have access to breast screening, diagnostics, surgery and treatment in SWFL. We work very closely with our Partners in Health network of physicians, hospitals and other providers to deliver the care needed, at significantly discounted rates. This network is extremely valuable and without them we could not exist.

Our organization receives no funding from the federal, state county or city governments. Our funding comes for individuals, fundraisers and grants. Our organization reaches out to Lee County residents through neighborhood associations and word of mouth and through the distribution of the flyers printed in 2 languages. We are a referral program and offer no direct medical services. In a mutual effort to help the uninsured and underserved, we work with many of the local human service organizations such as Family Health Center, The Salvation Army, The United Way, The Health Department and other agencies.

Together with our Partners in Health (radiologists, surgeons, anesthesiologists, pathologists, oncologists), we make a positive impact in the fight against breast cancer. We expect that the services we provide in SWFL will identify an increased number of breast cancers at an earlier stage, which in turn, decreases the severity of the disease. It has been shown nationally that increasing access to diagnostic testing and early intervention increases the probability of recovery. If women and men are denied access to care for financial reasons, the morbidity rate for breast cancer increases.

To qualify for our services, client must meet these qualifications and financial guidelines.
